

SPORTS CENTRE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION

CURLING – SEPTEMBER 2021

Vaccine Passport

- The <u>vaccine passport</u> is required for all persons aged 13 and over starting September 1st, 2021;
- Curling club management must put in place a verification tool (such as <u>Vaxicode Verif</u>);
- Maintaining a sign-in registry remains a sound practice but is not mandatory;
- If a positive Covid-19 case is registered, please communicate immediately with your regional public health office. They will inform you of the necessary steps required.

<u>Curling</u>

- The maximum number of participants is set at 25 people per *plateau*;
- One *plateau* includes one access point (entrance/door);
- During the practice of curling, wearing a mask is not required;
- Social distancing rules must be followed during all curling games (between the two teams, between skips, etc.);
- If contact remains occasional and brief, games may be played "normally" with two sweepers working simultaneously.

Restaurant/bar information

- <u>The vaccine passport</u> is required for all persons aged 13 and over starting September 2021;
- Please refer to the existing rules based on the permit your establishment holds.

Other important information

- The safety of all (participants, employees, volunteers, etc.) should remain at the heart of your concerns and decisions;
- For more detailed information, please contact your regional public health office;
- Social distancing rules must be adhered to at all times within the clubs (ex: locker and changing rooms, lobbies, waiting areas, etc.);
- Mask wearing remains mandatory when moving and walking about the curling club;
- Review and update as needed your cleaning and disinfecting protocols;
- Remain vigilant as these rules and guidelines may change at any time during the season.
