Re: Renewal of Your Curling Quebec Affiliation 2021-2022

Dear Presidents,

Our sincere hope is that the vaccination roll-outs will finally allow us to enjoy a normal curling season in 2021-22. We write to you today to inform you that the Curling Quebec Board of Directors has passed a resolution to extend last year's terms of affiliation.

During the 2019-20 season, the affiliated clubs that benefited from waived affiliation fees in 2020-21 will be granted the same benefit for the 2021-22 season, a saving of \$400/club for the relaunch of activities. In addition, the "Regular Curler" affiliation fee will remain at the same level in 2021-22, at \$21.74 per adult and \$11.74 per junior. Finally, the deadline for payment of membership fees remains **December 15**.

We kindly remind our club Presidents that Curling Quebec has the mandate to manage, develop and promote curling in our province. These affiliation fees represent, year in and year out, one-third of our operating budget. Therefore, it is an essential source of revenue that allows us to ensure the proper functioning of the federation and maintain and diversify our offer of programs and services.
