

JOB OFFER - ICE TECHNICIAN



High-quality ice is essential for the curling experience and practice. The Ice Technician position at (Club's name) aims to ensure proper ice maintenance at different times of the day and according to the needs of our clientele (leagues and rentals), so that the ice is in good condition for scheduled games. The person in this role is responsible for the following tasks:

- Preparing the stones and the ice at the beginning of the season (ice installation, painting, logos, game lines, cooling the stones, cleaning the walkway and boards, etc.)
- From Monday to Friday, performing two cuts per day: one early in the morning and one in the afternoon
- Taking samples and maintaining the water tower cooling system
- Applying pebble
- Performing end-of-season tasks (melting the ice, cleanup, removing logos, etc.)

Work Schedule

- The position is offered on a 5-day-per-week basis, at 8 hours per day for a 40-hour work week (when there is no tournament), from (start date) to (end date).
- The daily work schedule begins around 6:00 a.m. so that the ice is ready for morning games.
- Additional work hours may be required depending on the tasks to be completed, particularly at the beginning of the season and during tournaments.
- Volunteers assist with ice preparation outside the technician's regular schedule

Compensation

Compensation will be discussed with the selected candidate

Note : If individuals are interested in performing only part of the tasks and/or only at certain times of the week, responsibilities may be divided among several people under the supervision of a manager. The work schedule and compensation will then be determined based on the division of tasks.
