## Under-23 Lethbridge Classic

- One-time event held at the Lethbridge Curling Club in Alberta, March 3-6, 2022
- Invitational four-person Men's team event and four-person Women's team event
- Athletes can form a team with anyone in Canada
- Event will be held during the opening weekend of the 2022 Tim Hortons Brier and teams will watch the Wild Card game in person
- Format is round robin and eight teams will qualify for the playoffs. All games are 8 ends.
- Total cash prizes in the playoffs are \$20,000 per gender
- Entry fee per team is \$500 and teams must pay their own expenses
- Athlete ages are calculated on June 30, 2021; cumulative team age must be 88 years or less and no athlete can be under 20 years old
- Event starts on March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9am and ends on March 6<sup>th</sup> at 6pm
- Maximum 30 teams per gender

Age-eligible teams will be required to submit a written application to Curling Canada before 11:59PM EDT on December 1, 2021

All applications will be reviewed by an internal panel at Curling Canada and selected teams will be notified before December 10, 2021. Once teams have been selected, the event entry fee of \$500 will be due to Curling Canada before December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021. If selected teams do not pay their entry fee by December 23<sup>rd</sup> then teams next on the wait list will be invited.
