



MICHAEL D. « MIKE » CARSON

INDUCTED IN 2024

SUMMARY

It was in Deep River, Ontario that Mr. Michael D. Carson was born in 1946. Throughout his life, he lived in the Saguenay/Lac St-Jean region for more than forty years. His involvement in the sport of curling began in 1970 and his personal philosophy is that “Life without dreams is no life at all.”

An important figure in the world of curling, we cannot ignore his exploits over the 53 years he spent as a player. Whether it be his 25 participations in the Men's, Mixed, Senior and Masters provincial championships winning him more than 8 medals over the years or his 8 participations in the Senior and Masters national championships during which he received the Sportsmanship Award in 2001, it is hard to think of Mike's name without thinking of curling.

His involvement at the organizational level is equally remarkable. During his career he was involved in the Quebec Games, the Gala Sports Québec, the Canada Games, the Brier, the Canadian Masters championships and Curling Quebec, Mike played various roles in each of these organizations, either as director, administrator, technical director, coordinator, or vice-president.

To highlight his incomparable contribution, it is with pleasure that Curling Québec welcomes with great recognition, Mr. Mike Carson into its Hall of Fame as a player and builder.
